



Winter Registration

Registration for the Winter 2006 season is December 16th. Teams must have a minimum of 15 paid players. Otherwise, the team cannot be put on the schedule for the winter season.

Cost for the Season is as follows:

New players to the league pay \$80 (\$50 player fee, \$10 processing fee, \$20 insurance fee). Returning players from anytime last year who did **not** play in the Fall season pay \$70 (\$50 player fee, \$20 insurance fee). And for returning players that played in the Fall only pay the \$50

player fee.

Individuals can turn their money in to their team representative by December 16th. The registrar will be available to collect registration that day at Arthur Pack.

Make a note that if you are a new player or a late returning player you need to get your picture taken by December 16th to add to the team roster. A team fee will be charged if late players are added without a photo for the roster.

New Procedures

Check-in is now required 10 minutes before game time. We will give more time between games to make this possible. Both teams will have to come to the middle of the field as the 4th official checks in each player. The center ref will brief the teams on the reminder of the rules like; play nice or cards will

be shown.

No foul language, slide talking or violent conduct!

Uniforms for teams are required by the third game. Team reps need to order your uniforms by December 16th to have them by the first game of the season due to the holidays. If you do not have a team jersey you cannot play. NWASL is not

responsible for ordering your uniforms you are.

Be aware that NWASL will start checking other leagues before allowing new experienced players in our league.

Any person trying to play without paying or registering will be asked to leave the playing field by the field marshals.
