WINTER SEASON 2006 Registration

Winter registration is upon us. Early team registration is due Friday November 17th. A minimum of 15 paid players are required for your team to be registered. We want to have teams formed, scheduled and ready to go by early December. So if you need to add any extra players after your initial 15 are turned in by November 17th you may add late players until January. After the 3rd game during the winter season, all registrations will be considered late and have a \$10 late fee. The full registration fee will be charged. No more pro-rated amounts for late added players. You are encouraged to hold a full roster (20+ players) with anticipation for injury losses and circumstances since it won't be conducive to add late players. It takes a lot of work to put together the team binders for the Referees. So please get yourself and your team registered early. We have limited space for teams.

Our winter fields will be Sportspark, Desert Vista, Rillito, and 2 fields at Arthur Pack.

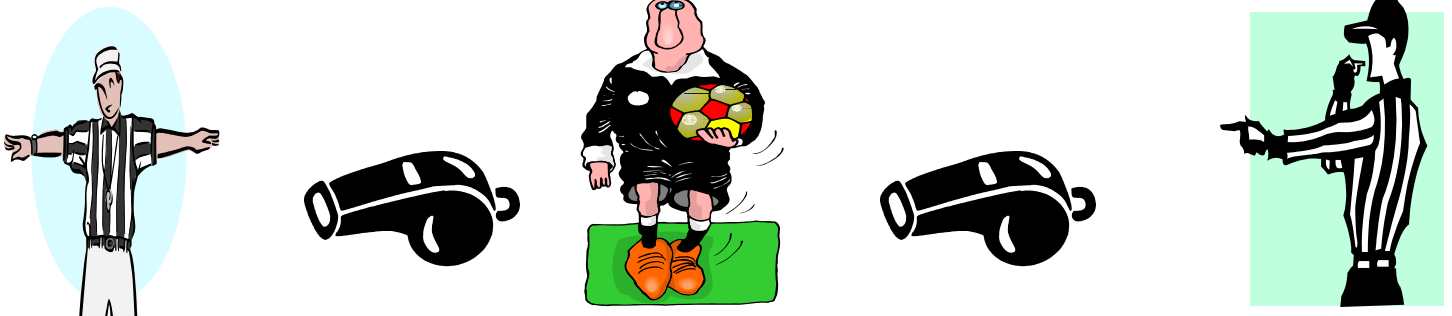

Playoffs will be December 1st and 8th. Remember good sportsmanship and trust the Referees to call the game. Our Good Sportsmanship team is still out there, so be mindful of your play.

PLAYOFF RULES & REGULATIONS

PLAYERS: A minimum of (7) players is required to start a game – 3 men field players, 3 women field players, and one goal keeper (can be either male or female, but if female does not count as one of the women field players). If a team cannot field at least (7) players with the above listed requirements, that team will have to forfeit the game. If a team does not have (5) women field players at the start of a game they can play with 3 or 4 but the ratio of men and women field players must be even. This does not include the goalkeeper. No guest players allowed.

SCORING: The following scale will be used to determine teams tournament standings:

Win	(6) Points
Tie	(3) Points
Loss	(0) Points
Goals	(1) Point per goal scored, first three goals only
Shut-Out	(1) Point (no shut-out point will be given for a 0-0 tie)
Forfeit	(9) Points (equal to 2-0 win)
Cards	(-1) Point for each yellow card received (-3) Points for each red card received

TIE BREAKER: In the event two teams are tied in points at the end of the preliminary rounds, the following will determine the team's placement in their division:

- Least red cards
- Least yellow cards
- Head to Head competition
- Least goals allowed
- Most goals scored
- Coin toss

GAME DURATION: The duration of all games will be two (2) equal 20 minute halves with a 1 minute half time period to switch sides of the field. Games will start promptly at scheduled time, if your team is on the field and ready to play within 5 minutes of the start time your team will forfeit the game.

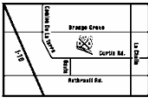
