Handbook: Our new league handbook will be available on line this season. Take a chance to read it so that you are familiar with the league policies and procedures.

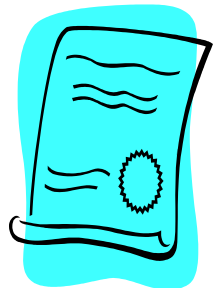
SPORTSMANSHIP AWARD GOES TO.....?

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW!!!

The next 4 weeks of our schedule will be posted soon on the league website. We are currently working with 3 playing fields. Rillito being a new addition. The field situation can change at any time so, make sure checking the website before your game becomes a habit in your routine of preparing to play.

If you are the first teams to play {6:00} field set up will be your job. This being the nets and flags. If you are the last teams to play { 8:40} your job is to take down the nets and flags. The nets and flags don't set themselves up so, if you want your games to start on time and not lose any playing time please be mindful of this important task.

Coming next week to the website will be a New Players Handbook that everyone in the league should read. There are always questions that players have regarding refs, conduct, slid tackling, rules of the game etc. It covers our league policies on a great many things that concerns you as a registered player.

Next season a new policy will go into effect regarding open players and, registration deadlines. A team must have at least 15 players to be considered a team and, to be put on the schedule for play. Open players {new registered players} will be put on teams that do not have the minimum 15. For example, if a team only has 13 registered paid players by the deadline your team will be filled with the open players. If you chose not to accept the open players your team will lose there spot on the schedule and a new team will be added. So as the next registration comes around please make a mental note that this policy will be in
